You can use these to gather information on (cyber)criminals who are (mis)using gaming platforms or obtain more information on a victim. Just like in gaming, success in OSINT requires strategy. You must think if you want to use a silent approach or to zero rush your opponent to obtain data. OSINT and gaming may seem like two completely different things, but they share more similarities than you might think. This skills session is for people who are interested in taking on their first quest into investigating gaming platforms.
